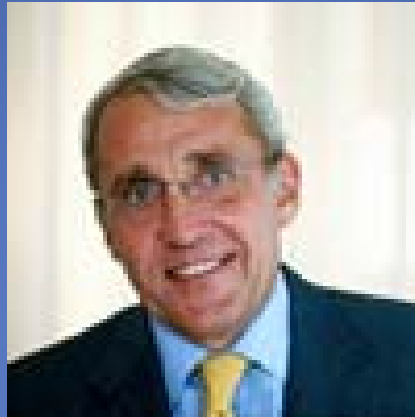

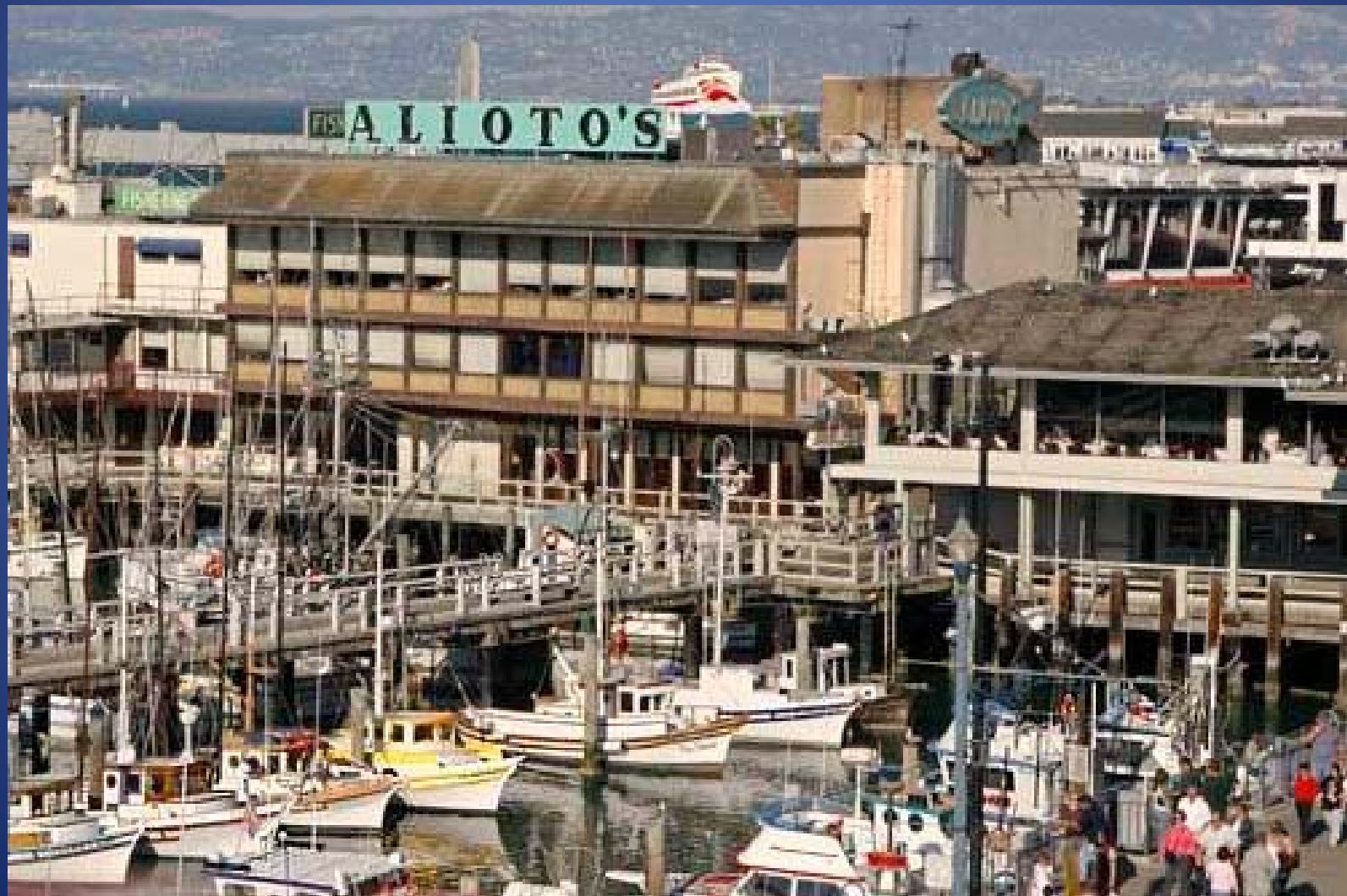
Technical Program
